



Paris Artist Residency

Terms & Conditions

Please ensure that you are aware of all Terms and Conditions before you apply for the Paris Art Residency Program, Studio of Qatar, at the Cite Internationale des Arts, Paris, France.

- The application to the Paris Art Residency is open to Qatari artists aged 18 and above, in all artistic disciplines and practices.
- Applicants are not required to have any formal or academic training in the Arts (i.e. BFA or MFA). Self-taught artists are equally eligible to apply to the residency.
- The residency will run for a period of 3 months with a mandatory art piece to be created during their stay at the residency and/or give a talk about their experience at the Cite Internationale des Arts Paris France.
- A panel of esteemed judges will review all applicants. All applicants will be notified via email about the jury's final decision regarding the selected artists.
- When applying, the artist should make sure to:
 - Applicant must complete the application form in full; along with the checklist, and hand deliver it to the Fire Station Reception desk. This should be the cover page of the submitted folder.
 - Applicant to present a body of work that most accurately represents their current art practice.
 - Submit high-resolution prints if applicant wishes to share any photographic work.

- All videos must be submitted on an accompanying USB stick, and provide a clear list of titles and media.
- It would be preferred if work can be organized in chronological order for the jury to follow the artist's progression and growth.
- Everything must be put into an A4 folder with a clear label on top stating in eligible text the applicant's name, phone number, and date of submission.

General Residency Guidelines

- The artist will be solely responsible for the upkeep and safeguarding of their studio space and the Cite Internationale des Art is not responsible for any objects or materials left in the studio.
- In the case of untimely termination or departure from the residency program, the artist is requested to inform Fire Station Senior Management.
- Fire Station and Qatar Museums will not be responsible in giving accepted applicants exemptions from work or studies. Fire Station and Qatar Museums will not be responsible in processing Schengen Visa. However the Fire Station will be able to provide letters attesting to the artists participation in the program for his/her perusal as proof of his/her attendance and participation in the Paris Art Residency Program, Studio of Qatar.
- Upon completion of the residency artists are required to:
 - Donate a minimum of one artwork to the Fire Station; this helps Fire Station to build a collection, which we will proudly display for years to come.
 - Give a public talk about their experience and insights gained at the Cite Internationale des Arts, Paris, as well as host an exhibition at Fire Station displaying their artworks created during the residency.
